

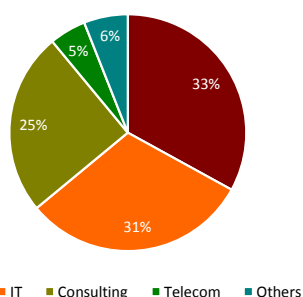

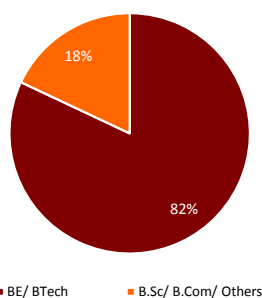

Curriculum

The programme is divided into 4 semesters with a summer internship at the end of the first year. The curriculum includes core courses and electives to specialise in Information Security, Networking and IT Infrastructure, Systems and Information Management.

The teaching pedagogy involves lectures, case studies, group projects as well as pilot projects in each year where live business situations are simulated.

The curriculum includes courses on self-development aimed at holistic learning for the students.

Industry Interaction

The institute had 22 guest lectures in the 2010-11 academic year.

The institute has tie-ups with reputed IT companies for industry lectures and internships. The institute has initiated efforts to become a SAP University and IBM University alliance partner where students can avail of additional IT courses beyond the curriculum.

Infrastructure

The institute shares a 41,000 square feet campus with 3 other Symbiosis institutes which offers 7 classrooms, 4 seminar halls and conference rooms.

Students have access to good hostel facilities along with a dedicated Health care centre and transport facilities which are part of the Symbiosis International university campus.

The institute has an excellent digital library which allows students to easily reference e-books and journals.

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
